[**ASB** – Although the number of ASB incidents have decreased from the previous three months, it is still a considerable high number, which is a concern. Thurmaston Beat Team are still issuing ASB warning letters and/or visits conducted to speak with parents/guardians, where youths have been identified. Ongoing patrols conducted by Thurmaston Beat Team and via OP EJECT, with Police Officers allocated to patrol in the Police Van and respond to ASB incidents across Charnwood on Friday & Saturday evenings/nights.

Damage – Six reports (Of the fourteen reported) of damage to the front wall of the garden/driveway of properties on 'The Dales' estate, in the early hours of 14/04/2012. Further Four reports (From the remaining eight) of damage incidents caused to fences & windows of properties on particular locations, Alexandra St, Elizabeth Dr, Mill Ln, & Sandiacre Dr, where there is an alleyway/footpath next to the property. There were similar reports in the 'MARCH' report, unfortunately No Witnesses/Suspects/Forensics/CCTV. Thurmaston Beat Team believe this to be youth related due to recent ASB at the locations and/or nearby locations. Parish Council have been informed and the possibility of having temporary gates installed to some of the alleyways/footpaths is under consideration (As per the 'MARCH' report).

Damage to motor vehicle – The single report was vehicle tyres being slashed, unfortunately No Witnesses/Suspects/Forensics/CCTV.

Theft of motor vehicle – No reports.

Theft from motor vehicle – Unfortunately No Witnesses/Suspects/Forensics/CCTV for all five reports. The second & fourth reports were exhaust / catalytic convertor stolen. Other three reports were damage to vehicle to gain entry and items stolen.

Burglary other than dwelling – No Witnesses/Suspects/Forensics/CCTV for all reports. The second and third reports were property stolen from business premises. The First and Fourth reports were property stolen from sheds & garages.

Burglary dwelling – The first report on Melton Rd was entry gained into property by forcing open the front door, and items stolen. Second report on Wayside Dr was entry gained to property by forcing rear door and a window, suspects were disturbed by the occupant and no items stolen. Third report on Melton Rd was entry gained via insecure window and items stolen. The Fourth report, on Northdown Dr, and Fifth report, on Church Hill Rd, was entry gained to property by smashing rear window and items stolen. All reports are currently under investigation and at present No Witnesses/Suspects/CCTV, but awaiting results from the Forensics.

Thurmaston Beat Team have recently identified suspects for various incidents with the help of CCTV. The reports are currently under investigation and consist of a Damage report on Elizabeth Park, Public Order incident on Silverdale Dr, Theft at RoundHill College, and a Theft report on Silverdale Dr.]
