[**ASB** – A little increase in the number of reported ASB incidents from the previous 3 months. Main locations being Winster Dr & Checkland Rd. Ongoing patrols conducted by Thurmaston Beat Team and via OP EJECT, with Police Officers allocated to patrol in the Police Van and respond to ASB incidents across Charnwood on Friday & Saturday evenings/nights.

Public Order – On 16/08/2012 about 15:30hrs, Police were called to ASDA Store, Thurmaston, reporting a male was jumping on the tills, wielding wine bottles and threatening violence. Customers & staff were escorted out of the store for their safety whilst Police attempted to arrest the male, with the assistance from the Police Firearms department. Male was arrested and taken to custody.

-- A police spokesperson said: "Police were called at 3.30pm to a supermarket in Barkby Thorpe Lane, Thurmaston, following a man threatening violence. "In the interests of public and officer safety, captor spray was used and a Taser was discharged to assist officers in arresting the man involved. Customers within the store were asked to leave for their own safety." --

Theft – The six reports of thefts were cycles stolen, where three were stolen from Havelock Gardens, two from Lonsdale Rd, and one from Rutland Dr. The reports from Havelock Gardens, nearby business CCTV was checked on Garden St, which shows persons walking up and down Garden St, then after some time cycling off, and also a white coloured van was seen during these times, which were between 03:00hrs & 05:00hrs on 08/08/2012. Unfortunately No Witnesses/Suspects/Forensics/CCTV for the reports on Rutland Dr & Lonsdale Rd.

Damage to motor vehicle – Third report on Garden St was damage caused to the window of a vehicle with suspect throwing stone(s), which is currently under investigation. Unfortunately No Witnesses/Suspects/Forensics/CCTV for the other three reports. First & Fourth reports were damage to windscreens, and Second report was damage to wing mirrors.

Theft of motor vehicle – First report was theft of motorcycle from the car park of the Raynsway Marina, on Pinfold Rd, Unfortunately No Witnesses/Suspects/Forensics/CCTV. Second report is still under investigation, where a vehicle that was hired to a client has not been returned.

Theft from motor vehicle – Unfortunately No Witnesses/Suspects/Forensics/CCTV for all three reports, where all three reports were theft of diesel from vehicles.

Burglary other than dwelling – No Witnesses/Forensics for all three reports, although CCTV shows a person outside business premises near the underpass, and currently await to see if this person can be identified.

Burglary dwelling – The First report on Church Hill Rd, where entry was gained via breaking the glass in the rear patio doors, and items stolen. The Second report on Unicorn St, where entry gained by forcing rear wooden door, not known if any items stolen. The Third report on Colby Dr, where entry was gained by forcing the front window of the property, and items stolen. And the Fourth report on Melton Rd, where rear window was smashed but believe no entry gained, whilst occupant of property was distracted at the front of the property. Unfortunately No Witnesses/Suspects/Forensics/CCTV for all four reports.]
