[**ASB** – Unfortunately the increased number of reported incidents have continued into the month of February.

As previously reported for the month of January, Thurmaston Beat Team had identified some youths and warning letters were being issued and/or visits conducted to speak with parents/guardians. Since most youths have been issued with warnings, the number incident reported in Thurmaston have reduced in the last couple of weeks, going into the month of March, with 3 reported incidents.

RE: Incidents at the retail park, Thurmaston Beat Team have spoken to management at the stores and discussed some problem solving plans, which have been put in place such as curfew times on serving persons under the age of 18 between specific days/times. This has seen the number of incidents at the retail park reduce considerably in the last couple of weeks, into the month of March, with only 1 reported incident.

The incidents on Church Hill Rd relate to youths gaining access to school grounds and causing disturbance to residents nearby. Thurmaston Beat Team have now got access to the school grounds and have regularly patrolled the location, and there have been no reported incidents in the last three weeks, going into the month of March.

The incidents on Sandiacre Drive were linked to a property, Thurmaston Beat Team worked with the landlords of the property, the tenants have now been evicted. No reported incidents since the eviction.

The incidents on the 'Dales Estate' RE: groups of youths causing disturbance to local residents. Thurmaston Beat Team have spoken to youths and they state they have nowhere to go and/or do anything. On further consultation we believe opening the Silverdale Park for a few more hours could be a solution, which would give the youths somewhere to go. (To be discussed at Parks Committee meeting).

Damage to motor vehicle – Unfortunately No Witnesses/Suspects/Forensics/CCTV for all reports. Reported damage to panels scratched & wing mirrors.

Theft of motor vehicle – No Reports

Theft from motor vehicle – Unfortunately No Witnesses/Suspects/Forensics/CCTV for all five reports. First and Third reports were exhaust / catalytic convertor stolen. Thefts varied from number plates, Fuel, & exhaust systems. Second and fourth reports were number plates stolen. Fifth report was window smashed and items stolen from inside vehicle.

Burglary other than dwelling – No Witnesses/Suspects/Forensics/CCTV for all reports. First and Second reports were items stolen from warehouse / factory units. Third and fourth reports were items stolen from garages.

Burglary dwelling – All five reports were forced entry gained to property, via windows/doors, and items stolen. No Witnesses/Suspects/CCTV/Forensics.]
