[ **ASB** – Unfortunately there has been a significant rise in the reported incidents of ASB, which are not at any one particular location. The incidents reported have been along Melton Rd, including some of the roads off Melton Rd (Garden St, Mill Ln, Wharf St, Alexandra St, Winster Dr), and Sandiacre Dr, including some roads off Sandiacre Dr (Charnwod Ave, Red Hill Ln, Checkland Rd). At present, the Thurmaston Beat Team have identified about 40% (27 names) of the groups of youths responsible for ASB in Thurmaston, Via CCTV at the Retail Park, which we believe are the same youths causing problems in our village. The youths identified are from Thurmaston, Syston, East Goscote & Barkby, but believe the main cause are youths from other areas such as Netherhall & Thurnby Lodge who have yet to be identified. Enquiries are still ongoing by the Thurmaston Beat Team and youths currently identified will be given written warnings and parent/guardians informed. About 90% of the ASB reported incidents did not involve alcohol. The incidents on Church Hill Rd relate to youths gaining access to school grounds and causing disturbance to residents nearby. The incidents on Parkdale Rd are group of local youths causing disturbance to local residents on 'The Dales' estate.

**Damage to motor vehicle** – Unfortunately No Witnesses/Suspects/Forensics/CCTV for all reports. Enquiries conducted by the Thurmaston Beat Team and believe the Damage caused to property in Thurmaston is linked to the ASB, with there being large groups of youths in Thurmaston. FYI - **Damage to motor vehicle**, there were 8 reports between 20/01/2012 to 27/01/2012 (as stated above), and **Damage** to property, there were 4 reports within the same period (3 x Sandiacre Dr, & 1 x Garden St).

**Theft of motor vehicle** – No Reports

**Theft from motor vehicle** – Unfortunately No Witnesses/Suspects/Forensics/CCTV for all four reports. Thefts varied from number plates, Fuel, & exhaust systems.

**Burglary other than dwelling** – No Witnesses/Suspects/Forensics/CCTV for the single report. Items were stolen from external storage container and shed.

**Burglary dwelling** – The First, Third, Fifth, & Seventh reports were forced entry gained to property, via windows/doors, and items stolen. The Second, Fourth, & Sixth reports were attempt burglaries, where the rear windows/doors of the property were damaged but no entry gained. No Witnesses/Suspects/CCTV/Forensics. ]
