Theft of motor vehicle – The single report on Clayton Dr, where suspect known to the victim takes the vehicle without owner's permission.

Theft from motor vehicle – Unfortunately No Witnesses/Suspects/Forensics/CCTV for all five reports. Entry was gained to vehicles by damaging the door locks and items stolen.

Burglary other than dwelling – The single report on Brook St was forced entry gained to a garage but no items stolen. Unfortunately No Witnesses/Suspects/Forensics/CCTV

Burglary dwelling – The first report was rear conservatory window smashed and entry gained to the property and items stolen. The second report was entry gained to property via insecure rear door whilst occupants were at home, and items stolen.
