[**ASB** – The months of May, June, & July have seen a considerable reduction in the number of reported incidents compared to the previous four months. Ongoing patrols conducted by Thurmaston Beat Team and via OP EJECT, with Police Officers allocated to patrol in the Police Van and respond to ASB incidents across Charnwood on Friday & Saturday evenings/nights.

Damage to motor vehicle – Unfortunately No Witnesses/Suspects/Forensics/CCTV for all five reports. First report was damage caused to interior of vehicle whilst parked on private car park. Second report was scratches to panels of vehicle. Last three reports were damage to wing mirrors.

Theft of motor vehicle – Attempt theft of motorbike from residential car park, where suspects were disturbed by owner. Report still under investigation.

Theft from motor vehicle – Unfortunately No Witnesses/Suspects/Forensics/CCTV for all four reports. The First report was theft of diesel from lorries. The Second and Fourth reports were theft of number plates. The Third report was theft of items from inside vehicle, where entry gained by smashing side window.

Burglary other than dwelling – No Witnesses/Suspects/Forensics/CCTV for this report, where four bikes were stolen from the garage.

Burglary dwelling – The First report on Melton Rd, where entry was gained via insecure rear door, whilst occupant at home. Some items stolen before suspects disturbed by occupant. The Second report on Ivydale Rd, where rear side door was forced to gain entry, and items stolen. The Third report on Melton Rd, where suspects force their way into the property and threaten the occupants, and items stolen. Report still under investigation. Unfortunately No Witnesses/Suspects/Forensics/CCTV for the first two reports.]
