[**ASB** – Although the number of ASB incidents have decreased from the previous two months, it is still a considerable high number, which is a concern. Thurmaston Beat Team are still issuing ASB warning letters and/or visits conducted to speak with parents/guardians, where youths have been identified.

Damage – Eight of the ten reported damage incidents have been caused to fences, greenhouses, & windows of properties on particular locations, Alexandra St, Elizabeth Dr, Garden St, & Sandiacre Dr, where there is an alleyway/footpath next to the property. Unfortunately No Witnesses/Suspects/Forensics/CCTV. Thurmaston Beat Team believe this to be youth related due to recent ASB at the locations and/or nearby locations. Parish Council have been informed and the possibility of having temporary gates installed to some of the alleyways/footpaths is under consideration. For example, if gates were installed they could be closed for a couple of hours on a Friday night (or any other day), which could be two/three times a month. Thurmaston Beat Team believe this will not have a major impact on members of the public who regularly use the footpaths/alleyways. This proposal will be put forward for public consultation, if there is a possibility of gates being installed.

Damage to motor vehicle – Three reports on Partridge Rd were linked to a domestic incident and currently under investigation. Unfortunately No Witnesses/Suspects/Forensics/CCTV for the reports on Checkland Rd & Manor Rd.

Theft of motor vehicle – The report for Humberstone Ln is currently under investigation as suspect(s) have been identified from fingerprints. Further enquiries still ongoing. Unfortunately No Witnesses/Suspects/Forensics/CCTV for report on White Hart Cl. Both reports were theft of motorbikes/mopeds.

Theft from motor vehicle – Unfortunately No Witnesses/Suspects/Forensics/CCTV for both reports. Both reports were exhaust / catalytic convertor stolen.

Burglary other than dwelling – No Reports.

Burglary dwelling – The report on Highway Rd was entry gained into property via insecure front door whilst occupant was at home. Occupant has disturbed the burglar, no items stolen. The report on Ivydale Rd was entry gained via insecure rear patio door and a vehicle stolen. The report on Colby Dr was forced entry via rear patio door and vehicle stolen. All other reports were forced entry gained to property, via windows/doors, and items stolen. No Witnesses/Suspects/CCTV/Forensics.]
