Damage to motor vehicle – The second report on Melton Rd was damage to driver side door window, which was in connection with a road rage incident, and suspect identified. Unfortunately No Witnesses/Suspects/Forensics/CCTV for the other five reports, first report was damage to rear windscreen, the third and fifth reports were damage to wing mirrors, the fourth report was scratches to panels of vehicle, and sixth report was dents to panels of vehicle.

Theft of motor vehicle – No Reports.

Theft from motor vehicle – The third report was damage to doors of vehicle and entry gained and various items stolen. Report currently under investigation as witnesses identified suspicious vehicle parked nearby and enquiries ongoing. Unfortunately No Witnesses/Suspects/Forensics/CCTV for the other three reports, The first and second reports were theft of catalytic converters from vans, and fourth report was damage caused to doors of van and works tools stolen.

Burglary dwelling – First report on Beverley CI where occupant heard some noises about 01:30hrs, on further inspection found rear patio door open, which was closed but not completely locked, no items stolen.
