Damage to motor vehicle – Unfortunately No Witnesses/Suspects/Forensics/CCTV for all four reports. The first three reports were scratches to panels of vehicle, and the Fourth report was rear windscreen smashed.

Theft of motor vehicle – No Reports.

Theft from motor vehicle – Unfortunately No Witnesses/Suspects/Forensics/CCTV for the five reports on Westmoreland Ave, where diesel fuel was stolen from vehicles & plant machinery. The Fifth report at the 'Retail Park' was theft of number plates from vehicle and currently conducting CCTV enquiries. The Seventh report was entry gained into an insecure vehicle and items stolen, suspects arrested and charged.

Burglary other than dwelling – Unfortunately No Witnesses/Suspects/Forensics/CCTV for all three reports. First report was an attempt to gain entry to a Public House. Second report was items stolen from a storage container on building site. And Third report was theft of items from a boat at the marina.

Burglary dwelling – The first report was side door of the property was forced to gain entry, and the remaining three reports were rear ground floor windows forced to gain entry to the property.
