[**ASB** – Unfortunately an increase in the number of reported ASB incidents, where five reports were in relation to youths messing about with / letting off fireworks on public highways. Ongoing patrols conducted by Thurmaston Beat Team.

Robbery – On 13/10/2012 there was an incident where two suspects entered a business premises on Humberstone Ln, and threatened staff with a firearm and stolen some property. Suspects identified, arrested and charged.

Damage to motor vehicle – Unfortunately No Witnesses/Suspects/Forensics/CCTV for both reports. The First report was scratches to panels of vehicle, and the Second report was plastic trims pulled off vehicle panels.

Theft of motor vehicle – No Reports.

Theft from motor vehicle – Unfortunately No Witnesses/Suspects/Forensics/CCTV for all Four reports. The First report was theft of external signage on vehicle. The Second report was entry gained to vehicle by damaging lock and items stolen. The Third report was cycle stolen from roof rack of vehicle. And Fourth report was theft of diesel fuel.

Burglary other than dwelling – This single report was a motorcross bike stolen from the garage, but located via GPS tracker device. Suspect identified and report currently under investigation.

Burglary dwelling – For the single report, the occupant was at home when suspect enters via unlocked side door, and items stolen. Unfortunately No Witnesses/Suspects/Forensics/CCTV for this report.]
